



RUMBLE ON THE REEF

Rumble on the Reef is an action sports festival based along the Great Barrier Reef coastline in Mackay Queensland with a range of events held over the September QLD School Holidays from 22nd SEPTEMBER to 4th OCTOBER 2020.

It includes the Australian National Championships of Skateboarding on the 25th and 26th of September, a cable wakeboarding competition on the 1st - 2nd October, freestyle BMX and ends with a kitefoil championship at Lamberts Beach.

Over the next 5 years, event organisers plan to grow this event into one of the biggest extreme sports action festivals in Australia.

Rider Registrations

Earlybird registration open 01 August - 31 August 2020 via the Live Heats platform. Each division entry fee is \$60 per person and gives riders access to discounts to passes at Wake House Australia in September 2020 and includes 1 x Wake House Australia rider wristband. (valued at \$7)

Registrations close strictly on Sunday 27th September 2020 at midnight.

Important: all competitors must have a valid waiver completed by a parent / legal guardian. Adult competitors complete it themselves. Head to www.wakehouse.com.au and click on 'sign up now' as a new customer. If you already have a WakeHouse account, you will not need to do this again. WAKEHOUSE OPEN | the competition

This will be a 1 lap competition starting at the kickers and ending back on the kickers. The riders will get 2 attempts at their run. The rider may hit any feature on the water and perform an air trick. It is recommended to hit as many features as you can in one run, however this does not mean that you will have the winning run. This competition will take into account style, intensity, diversity and complexity.

There will be 3 judges all sitting in separate locations. Judges decision is final and all scores are entered electronically into the LiveHeats platform for all competitors to view. Each divisions 4 highest scored riders proceed to the final round except for the PRO Women and Male divisions where 8 riders will proceed to the final round.

CASH FOR TRICKS | WakeHouse freestyle competition

This competition is all about rider progression!

No entry fees, all ages (must be at least 6yrs+) all rider levels, every carrier will be full for 2 hours of non-stop freestyle wakeboarding fun! One surprise set up right in front of the viewing area on the first straight. One judge will have the cash & a mic, handing out cash money for riders who progress and get the crowd excited! Make sure you stick around for this one, it's a lot of FUN and great entertainment.
